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All the District Educational Officers and Project Officers of SSA are informed that Divisional level ALA trainings – spell I are completed in the 3rd week of September 2017 as per the progs. read in reference 1. In continuation to these trainings, 2nd spell of trainings are rescheduled as per the reference 2nd cited.

In view of the effective involvement of MEOs in the implementation of ALA programme in all Mandals, it is also planned to provide orientation to all MEOs in your districts. Rescheduled activities are given in the table below.

In view of the above, you are requested to follow up keenly with the key activities mentioned hereunder.

1. The hourly schedule for the orientation of the MEOs training is annexed to these progs.
2. RiVER institute will supply infrastructure material like students tables, iron shelves, trays etc. along with ALA offline and online TLM to each ALA school in the state. Hence, kindly coordinate with RiVER district incharges for the proper distribution of the material to the schools.
3. Instruct MEOs to deploy CRPs to ALA schools during school set up and complex H.Ms to coordinate with them.
4. Head Masters of ALA schools shall be encouraged to launch the programme officially on the scheduled date with the huge participation of parents, villages, SMC members, alumni of the school, well wishers etc.
5. Master Coaches services are required for 3 months to provide full time on the job support to ALA schools w.e.f November 2017 to January 2018. Hence you are requested to provide substitute teachers/ eligible Academic instructors from the local village/habitation of the schools where Master Coaches are working, to ensure the delivery of instruction properly.
6. Core team members services are required to integrate the text book contents of 3,4 and 5 classes in to MGML pedagogy which is about to start soon after the launch of ALA schools. Hence you are requested to provide substitute teachers/ eligible Academic instructors from the local village/habitation of the schools where Core team members are working, to ensure the delivery of instruction properly.

In view of the above, you are requested to depute the Core team members, Master Coaches to attend the orientations and trainings as scheduled above, at the venues mentioned. This has got the approval of the Commissioner of School Education.

It is further informed that, State Coordinators for ALA programme, mentioned below are assigned observer duties to the districts allotted against their names, to monitor and provide proper feedback on the MEOs orientations and spell - 2 ALA trainings.
