Sub: School Education – Redeployment of LFL HMs to needy schools – Guidelines and orders – Issued – Reg.

The attention of all the District Educational Officers in the State is invited to the subject read above and they are informed that as per the norms, a primary school should have (200) strength in I to V Classes as per 1: 40 (ratio of T.P). Economic strength should be (100) in Primary School i.e., atleast 1:20 T.P. ratio.

In view of the above, the following guidelines are issued for shifting the LFL HMs to needy schools, where there is more than (100) strength:

GUIDELINES FOR REDEPLOYMENT OF LFL HMs

A). IDENTIFICATIOIN OF LFL HM POSTS FOR SHIFTING:

- i). The primary Schools having LFL HM posts and which are upgraded as Upper Primary Schools.
- ii). Primary Schools having strength below (50) and having LFL HM post.
- iii). Primary Schools having strength below (100) and having LFL HM post with High Female Literacy.

B). IDENTIFICATION OF NEEDY PRIMARY SCHOOLS FOR SHIFTING OF LFL HMs:

Preferential Order

- i). Primary Schools having (200) and above strength in rural areas.
- ii). Primary Schools having (100) and above strength with low Female Literacy in rural areas.
- iii). Primary Schools having (100) and above strength in rural areas.

All the District Educational Officers in the State are instructed to identify the schools for shifting of LFL Head Masters on redeployment basis to the needy schools duly following the above guidelines.

The redeployment should be preferably done within the Mandal in the first instance and once the Mandal requirement is met, the adjacent mandals should be taken up for consideration.

This order is given keeping in view the public interest towards efficient functioning of schools.
