- 1. Application (s) must be submitted before the last date to the concerned District Educational Officer only.
- 2. The candidate must remit the Examination fee of **Rs.100/-(OC/BC)** and of **Rs.50/-(SC/ST/PH)** in form of DD in favour of "**DIRECTOR OF GOVT. EXAMS. AP HYD**" through **SBH / SBI only** and submit the Application with Demand Draft.
- 3. Candidates who secured 55% and above are alone eligible in case of OC/BC, 50% and above in case of SC/ST/PH or equivalent grade i.e., **B**<sup>+</sup> **for all categories.** OC & BC candidates secured even 54.99% and SC/ST/PH candidates secured 49.99% are not eligible. The percentage should not be rounded off and treated as 55% or 50% as the case may be, Such candidates are not eligible.
- 4. Candidate should furnish either his/her AADHAAR Number or Enrollment Number (Item No: 20).
- 5. DBT districts i.e. Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, East Godavari, Krishna, Guntur, Kurnool, YSR kadapa, Chittoor, Ananthapur.
