For Example: i. For upgraded UP schools (VIII class) where enrollment justifies allocation of additional teachers. ii. For High Schools where the class strength is over 50 students. iii. Providing of academic monitoring support to Mandal Educational Officers. iv. Deputation to DIETs / CTEs as per requirement, etc.,
