The Commissioner & Director of School Education has already been requested to provide required no. of regular teachers and Headmasters through redeployment in such schools in all districts. Apart from positioning of required no. of regular teachers, it was also decided to take up certain activities under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan like providing sufficient TLE / TLM, additional classrooms depending on the enrolment of the children, computer with internet facility etc., as part of infrastructure development to implement the above programme effectively.

Therefore, they are requested to include the following activities in the AWP&B 2013-14 in their respective district plans along with budget under "Innovative Activities". They are further requested to add one sub head under "Innovative Activity" i.e., "providing additional facilities for strengthening of primary schools with more than 100 enrolment".

Strengthening of select primary schools with more than 100 enrolment

Though considerable progress is made in respect of access, enrolment and retention to the expected level, there is not much improvement noticed in quality education in Government schools. It is also evident from ASER Survey that the quality of education among primary school children in the district is very low.

Problems & Issues

The following are the main issues

- Poor monitoring of schools
- Existence of multi grade teaching due to lack of sufficient strength and less no. of teachers to different classes and subjects
- ❖ Teachers dealing all subjects of same class throughout the day leading to monotonous in classroom teaching and resulting in boredom to students and ineffective classroom management
- ❖ Lack of child friendly learning environment in schools

Quality has also been a major concern of Government of India and State Governments. Therefore, it is proposed to implement a special programme for enhancement of quality in ______ selected primary schools where the strength of children is more than 100.

Strategies for implementation

It is proposed to take up the above programme by implementing the following strategies.

- ❖ All Government / Localbody primary schools with 100 and above children will be selected under this programme.
- Minimum 5 teachers will be provided to each school i.e., one teacher per class.
 Additional requirement of teachers may be adjusted through rationalization

- of teachers. If the enrolment is more than 150, one HM and additional teacher shall be provided as per RTE norms.
- ❖ To dispense with the existing practice of allotting one class per one teacher and to adopt subject-wise time table i.e., one teacher dealing different subjects to different classes in a day.
- ❖ To increase the frequency of academic monitoring of these schools
- ❖ To provide necessary TLM / TLE for effective teaching learning process
- Less involvement of teachers in non academic work and to enhance the time on task for teaching learning.
- ❖ To provide sufficient no. of classrooms depending on the enrolment of children
- ❖ To orient the teachers frequently on difficult concepts in different subjects and also to motivate them for achieving better standards among children.
- Regular on job support to teachers in imparting difficult concepts very easily to children
- Providing one computer with internet facility to these schools for effective monitoring of attendance of children.

Budget requirement

For effective implementation of the programme, the following activities are proposed in each school along with required budget
